

**Temporary Storage Containers
Policy Resolution 22**

The duly elected Board of Directors of The Woods at Polaris Condominium Association establishes the following policy regarding the use of temporary storage containers:


The use of a temporary mobile storage container (such as "PODS" or Portable On Demand Storage, "GO MINI'S", etc.) is permitted with the following limitations:

1. The use of one (1) storage container on shall be limited to four (4) consecutive days, or four (4) total days within a twelve (12) month period. The Unit Owner must call the Property Manager for permission before having the POD delivered.
2. Storage containers must be placed on the driveway apron contiguous to the Unit Owners garage and may not block normal access for other residents.
3. No portable storage container shall have dimensions greater than 16 feet in length, 8 feet in width, or 8 ½ feet in height.
4. All portable storage containers shall be in a condition free from rust, peeling paint and other forms of deterioration.
5. No storage container shall be placed in the street.
6. No storage container shall be placed in a lawn.
7. Storage containers shall be kept closed and locked when not being loaded or unloaded
8. If the container exceeds the 4-day limit, it may be towed at the owner's expense.
9. The Unit Owner accepts all liability for the PODS or storage unit while on premises including any damage done to the property or the storage unit.


